SHABBATON FAQs

Who is eligible?

1. JewQ Champions with an average of 70% on all three tests.
2. Parents and siblings of participants are invited as well. Siblings will join the children's program, and parents will have an exciting and meaningful parent program.

Who will supervise?

Every child joining the program must be accompanied by a chaperone who will be traveling with them to and from the Shabbaton.

During camp, your child will be assigned to a bunk with counselors responsible for their care.

The Chaperone will be responsible for your child at night and during any breaks.

When is the shabbaton?

The Shabbaton opens with registration at 8:30 am on Friday, April 5th-26 Adar 2. The program will begin at 9:30 AM. The Shabbaton concludes at approximately 3:00 pm on Sunday, April 7th- 28 Adar 2.

**There is an option to arrive on Thursday evening with supper and lodging, for an additional fee.*

Where is the Shabbaton?

What is being done about safety?

There will be armed security throughout the entire Shabbaton. Only those registered will be allowed on the Shabbaton.

What is the cost of the Shabbaton?

There are three tiers for pricing, parents can choose what price to pay per participant.

- 1) Regular Price: \$625
- 2) Partial Subsidy: \$475
- 3) Subsidized: \$350

**within each tier the more people you bring up to 4 people its an additional \$25 off of each*

**Thursday early arrival additional cost \$200 per room*

What does the Program Include?

- Lodging - 2 Night hotel stay
- Food - 3 meals a day, plus snacks
- Trips
- Activities
- Tickets to the JewQ International Torah Championship Show and Concert

How does transportation work?

Bus transportation will be available from Crown Heights to the hotel Friday morning.

Bus transportation back to Crown Heights will be available Sunday afternoon.

Parking is available for an additional fee paid directly to the hotel.

Transportation will be provided throughout the Shabbaton.

Registration opens on February 5th and closes on March 12th.
